AGREEMENT

The Belpre City Health Department and the Athens City-County Health Department enter into the Agreement as specified below on the 10th day of January 2014.

The Belpre City Health Department has concerns and desire to see that certain environmental health standards are met to provide the residents of Belpre for a clean, safe and healthy environment in which to live. In consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual agreements set forth hereinafter, the Belpre City Health Department and the Athens City-County Health Department agree to the following covenants.

The Belpre City Board of Health has at their regular monthly meeting on January 10, 2014, by majority vote by a quorum of members, resolved to enter into a contract with the Athens City-County Health Department to provide support for a Sanitarian who will provide the following services:

- All field activities and field reports, necessarily performed by a Sanitarian
 in compliance with the Ohio State Board of Sanitation Registration, in
 support and compliance with requirements of the Ohio Food Service Law,
 the Ohio Manufactured Home Park Law, the Ohio Marina Law and all
 other environmental health activities as mandated by the Ohio Public
 Health Council, and the Ohio Department of Health.
- A summary of all activities and time spent in performance of these duties, to be presented monthly to the Belpre City Board of Health for their review.

SERVICE PAYMENTS

The Belpre City Board of Health will pay the Athens City-County Health Department an hourly rate for the service provided, including time in transit to and from Athens, Ohio, not to exceed \$30.00 per hour, for hours determined by the Board of Health, to conduct the duties of The Belpre City Health Department Sanitarian. The total mileage traveled by the Sanitarian both to and from Athens, Ohio and within the City of Belpre in his/her own vehicle or one owned by the Athens City-County Health Department shall be reimbursed by the Belpre City Board of Health at the federal rate per mile.

This agreement will not be modified unless both The Belpre City Health Department and the Athens City-County Health Department consent to said modifications in writing. Should either party elect to terminate this Agreement for reasons other than improper performance of conditions set forth in this Agreement, written notice of termination must be given to the other party thirty (30) days prior to such termination.

This agreement will begin on February 1, 2014 and will remain in effect until January 31, 2015.

The parties execute the Agreement on the date shown above by signing the names of the authorized persons below.
