A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE PUBLIC DEPOSITORY FOR ACTIVE, INACTIVE AND INTERIM FUNDS OF THE CITY OF BELPRE, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Belpre, Ohio, finds that notice for application for deposit of City moneys was duly published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, Peoples Bank, N.A., Huntington Bank, and WesBanco Bank were the only institutions to bid for the deposit of public funds of the City of Belpre; and

WHEREAS, the applications hereinafter described were all that had been received, and they applied for said public moneys to be deposited with them, to include active deposits, inactive deposits and interim deposits; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Belpre, Ohio, finds that the sureties and securities tendered are proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELPRE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I

Pursuant to Section 135.04, Ohio Revised Code, active deposits of the City of Belpre shall be deposited for the next five (5) years as follows:

The Treasurer may deposit the first \$25,000.00 of active deposits at Peoples Bank, N.A., or WesBanco Bank on the basis of the operating needs of the City. The balance of active deposits shall be awarded to the institution providing the highest interest bid at the time of the investment.

SECTION II

Pursuant to Sections 135.05, 135.06 and 135.07, Ohio Revised Code, inactive deposits for the next five (5) years shall be awarded to the institution providing the highest interest bid at the time of the investment.
