

Frequently Asked Questions

- Are the trees in my yard my responsibility to maintain? Yes. Anything behind the sidewalk is generally the landowner's responsibility.
- What is a City-owned tree? Trees that are located along streets & City-owned property including public areas.
- Who maintains the City trees? The Belpre Tree Commission in conjunction with the Streets Dept. oversees or completes maintenance.
- How do I determine if a tree is mine or the City's? To be sure, contact the Belpre Safety Service Director @ 740-423-7592.
- Do I need permission to trim or remove a City tree? Yes.
- How do I request a City tree be trimmed or removed? Contact the Belpre Safety Service Director a 740-423-7592.
- Where can I get advice on the type of tree to plant on my property? The Tree Commission offers advice on tree species selection, planting tips, & maintenance.
- Know do I purchase a Memorial Tree, Bench or Swing? Contact the Mayor @ 740-423-7592.

Did You Know?

- The City of Belpre owns all 500 plus trees located on.....
 - \Rightarrow Lawn strips (area between sidewalks & curb)
 - \Rightarrow City Rights of Way
 - \Rightarrow All City-owned property (example: Parks)

Dos and Don'ts

- Homeowners & Businesses
 - \Rightarrow <u>Don't</u> trim, prune, or remove city owned trees
 - ⇒ <u>Do</u> contact the Safety Service Director if a tree needs attention: Call 740-423-7592
 - \Rightarrow <u>Do</u> report violations: Call 740-423-7592
