**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND BELPRE CODE OF ORDINANCES
SECTION NO. 939.04, EXHIBIT A**

WHEREAS, the City Council and Safety-Service Director of the City of Belpre has determined that replacements and improvements must be made to the City of Belpre water systems; and

WHEREAS, said replacements and improvements will constitute long-term capital improvement to the water system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELPRE, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I

Belpre Code of Ordinance Section 939.04 RATES FOR WATER, Exhibit A shall be amended to include a new subsection titled: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND - \$6.00 per month water rate increase for all users of the Belpre City water users whether inside or outside the City limits.

SECTION II

(A) The \$6.00 water usage increase shall initially be allocated as follows:

\$4.00 per month shall be dedicated to the repayment of any indebtedness to the City of Belpre for the construction of a new water storage facility

\$2.00 shall be allocated to a long-term capital improvement fund for the Belpre City water supply system.

(B) Upon payment of all the indebtedness for the new Belpre water storage facility, the entire \$6.00 per month shall be allocated to the long-term capital improvement fund for the Belpre City water supply system.

SECTION III

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.

An Ordinance Approving The Maintenance, Resurfacing
Project In The City of Belpre on State Route 618

PRELIMINARY LEGISLATION

The following is hereby enacted by the Council of the City of Belpre, Washington County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the LPA/STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Maintenance resurfacing project in the City of Belpre on State Route 618. Work includes pavement repair, asphalt resurfacing, pavement marking, and curb ramps. Begin work at the enter Belpre Corporation limit and end work at State Route 32. Total length of work in the City of Belpre is approximately 10.53 miles.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Belpre, Ohio.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above-described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

The City does hereby propose to assume and contribute the entire cost and expense of the improvement, less the amount of Federal Aid Funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for financing this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, and further, the City agrees to bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the following items:

- 1) Rights-of-Way

2) All costs for added construction items generating extra work contracts under Ohio laws, unless performance is approved by the State of Ohio and Federal Highway Administration before work is authorized.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C., Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for such maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the Right-of-Way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI - Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said City of Belpre, Ohio, is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Belpre, Ohio to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above-described project.
